Along with **Royal St Georges**, **Royal Cinque Ports** and **Princes Golf Club**, you can even tee off on the world-famous white cliffs themselves, at the **Walmer & Kingsdown Golf Club**.

This unique course delivers stunning sea views across the English Channel to the French coast. It's one of only a few courses anywhere in the world where golfers can glimpse another country while enjoying a round!

The golfing aficionados will want to play all four courses and if this is the case, be assured that there is plenty to do for the remaining part of the day!



DAY 1

Morning - Royal St Georges Golf Club

With its famously challenging 18-holes set in 450 acres of DDI dune land, Royal St George's Golf Club is one of Britain's finest links golf courses. Golfers can enjoy beautiful surroundings and stunning sea views.

The club, situated in Sandwich, has hosted 'The Open Championship' 15 times, most recently the 149th Open in July 2021. The course also proudly hosts other numerous tournaments for both amateur and professional golfers from across the world.

Afternoon – Have a wander around Sandwich

Sandwich is one of the original Cinque Ports - Once a bustling and prosperous port, it is now said to be “one of the most well-preserved medieval towns in Britain”.

Have a wander through the unspoilt medieval streets where there are more half-timbered houses than any other street in England. The newly refurbished quayside is a must and gives a good flavour of the history and heritage surrounding the town.

The town has a great range of independent shops and places to eat and drink. Food has always been associated with the town - in the 18th century the Earl of Sandwich is reputed to have devised the popular snack, and this is celebrated in the annual food festival.

Evening

Why not extend your afternoon wander into the evening and enjoy everything from authentic pizza overlooking the quayside, through to great Mediterranean food close to the heart of Sandwich.

DAY 2

Morning – Walmer and Kingsdown Golf Club

Perched on top of the world-famous White Cliffs of Dover, with sea views from every hole, the unique location of this beautiful course delivers stunning views across the English Channel to the coast of France. Walmer and Kingsdown is one of only a few courses in the world where golfers can see another country while enjoying a round.

The fantastic 18-hole course offers a challenge to all abilities.

Afternoon – Explore the villages of Kingsdown and St. Margaret's

Kingsdown is a quaint village, close to the sea and cliffs and rather unusually nowadays, has 3 pubs! On the seafront you will find a fantastic little pub for coffee in an unrivalled spot where you can watch ferries making the short crossing to France. A short drive (or a worthwhile longer walk); the pretty village of St Margaret's was home to Noel Coward who had a house on the seafront and sold it to Ian Fleming for inspiration for writing his books about James Bond. Moonraker and Goldfinger are largely based in the village and Kingsdown area. Fleming also loved golf and was a member of Royal St Georges until his death in 1964.

There is a wonderful windy road down to a secluded bay, which whisk you back to perfect childhood holidays.

DAY 3

Morning – Princes Golf Club

Princes is a classic 27-hole Championship links course and was host to 'The 67th Open' in 1932, won by Gene Sarazen. This internationally renowned golf club welcomes visitors from across the world, seven days a week.

Morning - Royal Cinque Ports

The 18-hole Championship links course at Royal Cinque Ports has fast rolling fairways and superb greens providing a challenging game.

The well-presented playing surface is firm and undulating, challenging players' skills with steep bunkers and, of course, a sea breeze! With excellent practice facilities and said to be one of the finest links golf courses in the British Isles, Royal Cinque Ports hosted 'The Open Championship' in 1909 and 1920. They are also a final qualifying course for 'The 149th Open' when it returns in 2021.
